Green Jutland Corridor – a West Scandinavian corridor

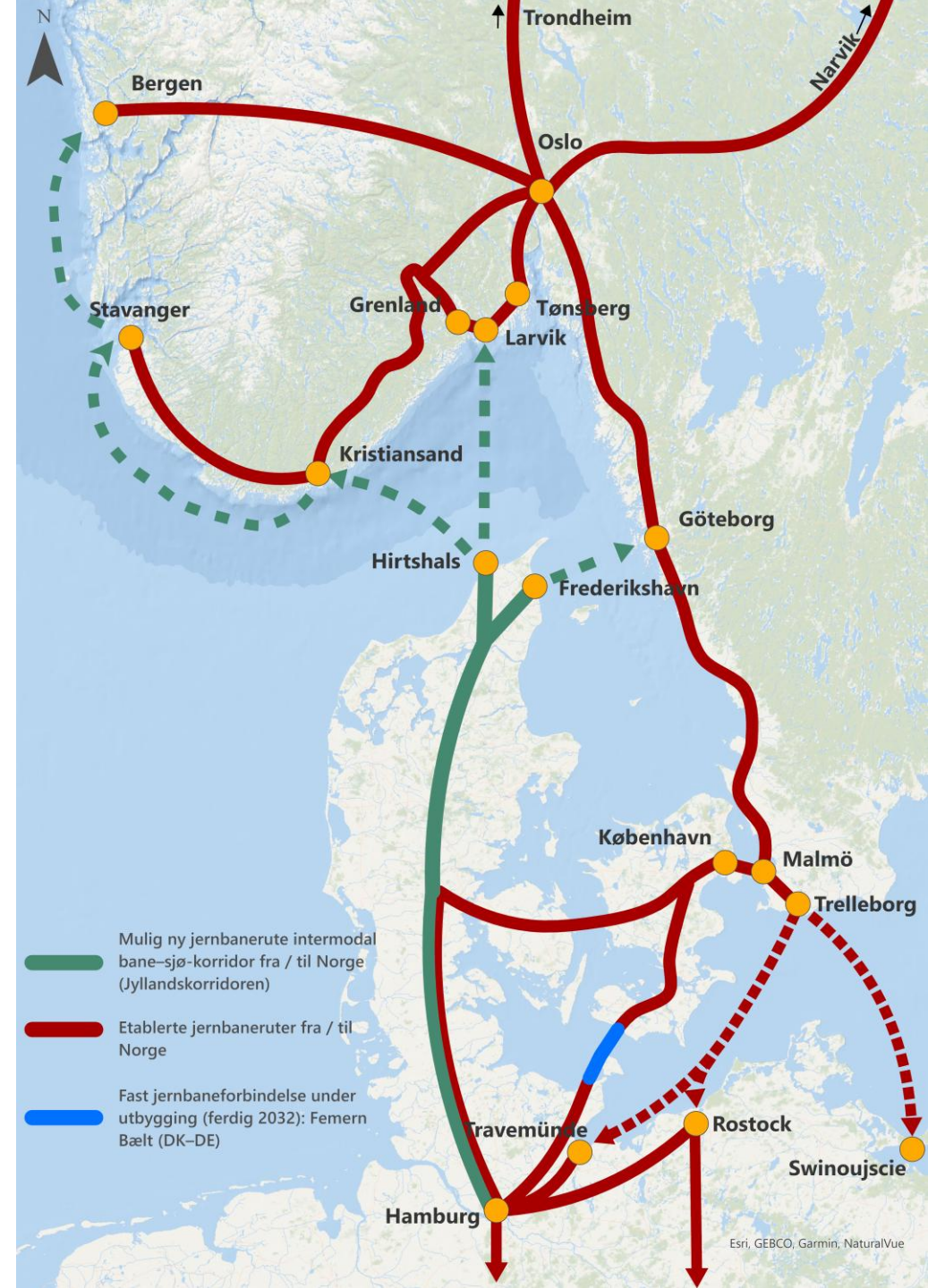


- Connects Southern Norway, Western Sweden and Jutland with Europe
- Combines ports, ferry links, rail and road
- Direct and complementary north-south corridor
- Major freight and industrial corridor across the Skagerrak
- Supports resilience, security of supply and military mobility



Green Jutlandcorridor – potential as a second cross-border railfreight corridor in West-scandinavia

- Corridor via Sweden = today's main railfreight corridor
- The Jutland corridor = alternative/redundancy

- Existing multimodal infrastructure
- Strong freight market

- Growing European focus on resilience

Challenges

- Rail bottlenecks and limited capacity
- Missing electrification and terminal access
